What is a Dental Emergency?

- Trauma to the Teeth
- Uncontrolled Dental Pain
- Uncontrolled Bleeding from the Mouth
- Facial Swelling (altered appearance)
- Swelling Inside the Mouth
- Ulceration
- Altered Sensation (face or mouth)
